

Instructions mentioned on the Call Letter/Admit Card & Syllabus for Examination

1. Reference to your application for the post of **Scientist 'C' in the Pay Band- 3, Rs. 15600-39100 + Grade Pay Rs. 6600** you are hereby directed to appear for a written examination on **19th March 2017** at **09:00 A.M.** at Kendriya Vidyalaya, C-2 Area, Janakpuri, New Delhi-110058. The examination will start sharp at 10.00 A.M. and you must reach the venue of examination at least one hour prior to the commencement of examination. The exam will be of **two hours duration**. **The written test would be of 100 marks consisting of 100 questions of one mark each for the correct answer. For each wrong answer 0.25 marks shall be deducted. Out of 100 questions, 90 questions shall be of objective/Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) type and 10 marks will be based on comprehension/analytical skill based on GRE pattern. Level of questions will be M.Sc. and generally covering the subjects mentioned in the Advertisement, General Scientific Knowledge, Current Affairs and developments in Biomedical Sciences, Common Sense, Institute Specific areas and Fundamental Knowledge.**
- 2 This Admit Card must be surrendered in the examination hall to the invigilator. Therefore, you are advised to retain a photocopy of this letter with you.
- 3 In case, any candidate is found indulged in using any unfair means, cheating etc., his/her candidature will be cancelled forthwith without any notice besides taking other action as deemed fit under the rules /debaring him/her to appear in the future vacancies of NIMR, as the case may be.
- 4 It may please be noted that you have been called for a written examination which does not necessarily means that you fulfill all the eligibility criteria for appointment. Based on the marks obtained in the written examination and screening, only the shortlisted candidates will be called for interview. **You may also note that eligibility criteria/ original documents/ testimonials will be checked at the time of interview of shortlisted candidates and in case these are not found in order, it will be treated as disqualification irrespective of your marks, obtained in the written test.**
- 5 In case of any blind candidate (if any), special assistance / special type of question paper are required, it should be informed at least 15 days before commencement of the examination or on the date of receipt of this letter, whichever is later, to the undersigned in writing. No such request would be entertained on the day of the examination.
- 6 **All the instructions of the written test would be on the questionnaire booklet. Candidates are advised to strictly adhere to those instructions while answering the same.**
- 7 Any misbehavior with the invigilators in the examination hall, if come to the notice, would amount to cancellation of the candidature of such candidates and no correspondence/request in this regard would be entertained later on, whatsoever it may be. Candidates are requested to maintain peace in the examination hall and extend their co-operation to the invigilators, so that written test may be completed in a peaceful manner.
