1. Scientists 'D': Two (UR)

**Pay Band- 3, Rs. 15600-39100 + Grade Pay Rs. 7600
& other allowances as per Rules at the ICMR's National Institute of Malaria Research,
Delhi**

Essential Qualifications :

- i) First class Master's degree in life/ biological sciences (Zoology, Biology, Applied Biology, Biotechnology, Medical Entomology etc.) from a recognized university.
Or
Second class M.Sc + Ph.D. degree in any of the above subjects of the life/ biological sciences from a recognized University
- ii) Eight (8) years R&D/Teaching experience in vector biology and control in malaria and other Vector Borne Diseases from a recognized Institute/ University after obtaining one of the above degrees.

Post – I : Desirable Qualifications

- Doctorate degree with demonstrated research work in vector biology and control in malaria and other Vector Borne Diseases from recognized university.
- Additional post doctoral research/teaching experience in Field Entomology, Bioecology of the vectors, Insecticide resistance and vector control with publication in high impact factor journals. Demonstrated research capabilities and competency as an independent investigator. Knowledge of computer application.

Post – II : Desirable Qualifications

- Doctorate degree with demonstrated research work in molecular entomology, vector biology and control in malaria and other Vector Borne Diseases from recognized university.
- Additional post doctoral research/teaching experience in vector parasite interaction biology, Bioecology of the vectors and vector control with publication in high impact factor journals. Demonstrated research capabilities and competency as an independent investigator. Knowledge of computer application.

2. Scientists 'C': One(UR)

**Pay Band- 3, Rs. 15600-39100 + Grade Pay Rs. 6600
& other allowances as per Rules at the ICMR's National Institute of Malaria Research,
Delhi**

Essential Qualification:

A) First Class Master's degree in Biophysics/Molecular Biology/Zoology/Biochemistry/
Biotechnology/ Bioinformatics/Physiology/ Mathematics/ Statistics/ Geostatistics and
other related subjects in Life/ Physical Science from a recognized University

Or

Second Class M.Sc + Ph.D degree in Biophysics/Molecular
Biology/Zoology/Biochemistry/ Biotechnology/ Bioinformatics/Physiology/
Mathematics/ Statistics/ Geo statistics and other related subjects in Life/ Physical
Science from a recognized University.

B) Four (4) years R&D/Teaching experience in malaria and other Vector Borne Diseases
from a recognized Institute/ University after obtaining one of the above degrees.

Desirable Qualification :

- i) Doctorate degree in the field of Malaria or other vector borne diseases.
- ii) Additional Post Doctoral research/teaching experience from recognized institute in
Bioinformatics, related Computer Applications.
- iii) Knowledge of Computer Applications /Data management/M. Tech/ M.C.A.
- iv) Experience in use of modern tools such as GPS, GIS & development of Mobile
application for health research.

Job Requirement :

To Plan, formulate and carry out research work on malaria and other vector borne
diseases, to supervise research work and carry out any other work assigned by the
director.

Age Limit: Not exceeding 45 years for Scientist D and 40 years for Scientist C as on 19.08.2016.
Relaxable up to 5 years for Government servants and SC/ST/OBC candidates in accordance with
the instructions issued by the Department of Personnel and Training from time to time in this
regard.

General Relaxation clause:

- i) The prescribed age may be further relaxed in exceptional cases for experienced and qualified candidates.
- ii) One time age relaxation is also allowed to Scientific and Technical Staff working in long term projects in ICMR Institutes/Centres for posts advertised under HRSC, 2007 provided they meet essential qualifications and experience for the post with a view to provide them opportunity to compete with other candidates as per Council's letter No.6/1/2007-Admn.II dated 28.3.2011.
- iii) Age, Qualification and Experience will be relaxable in deserving cases as mentioned in the Recruitment Rules of Health Research Scientists cadre of ICMR, 2007 under Rule 14 and Notes 1, 2 & 3 of Schedule III.

Note 1:

- 1) Ph.D in the relevant subject shall be treated equivalent to three years experience.
- 2) Candidates with Ph.D. degree will be preferred for direct recruitment.
- 3) If no suitable candidate is found the post can be filled at one level below
- 4) Since it is not possible to call all the eligible candidates for the interview/personal discussion, the applicants will be short-listed for this purpose. The decision of the Director General, ICMR will be final in this regard.
- 5) Candidates called for interview will be paid a 2nd class rail fare by the shortest route on production of documents.
- 6) Any canvassing by or on behalf of the candidates or to bring political or other outside influence with regard to selection/recruitment shall be treated as disqualification.
- 7) This post is with all India transfer liability under the Council.
- 8) Experienced and meritorious candidates may be granted higher pay scale on recommendation of the Selection Committee.

- d) Crossed Indian Postal Order (IPO) for Rs.100/- (Rupees One hundred only) payable to the Director, National Institute of Malaria Research, Sec 8, Dwarka, Delhi 11007. SC/ ST/ women and physically handicapped (PH) candidates are exempted from the application fee. IPOs are payable by all other candidates including ICMR employees. Indian Scientists working abroad are exempted from application fee.
- 4) Applications from employees working in Central/State Govt. Departments/Public Sector Undertakings and Govt. funded research agencies must be forwarded through proper channel. Advance copies of application will be considered subject to the conditions that a "No Objection Certificate" from the employer is produced at the time of personal discussion. Application received after the closing date will not be considered. Candidates called for personal discussion/interview have the option to answer in Hindi also.
- 5) Unsigned/Incomplete application or application without supportive evidence asked for/without postal order and application received late shall be summarily rejected.
